

Naval Science Awards Recipients Selection and Recognition

Technology Management Training Group, Inc. (TMT Group, Inc.) administers the Naval Science Awards Program on behalf of the Office of Naval Research (ONR). Senior and junior division award packets are explained below.

The number of award packets (Senior and Junior divisions) mailed to the Awards Special Chairperson depends on the number of student exhibits, based on the chart below. The same table is used to determine both senior and junior division packets. (Example: if your fair has 250 senior division exhibits and 325 junior division exhibits you will receive 5 senior division award recipient envelopes and 6 junior division award recipient envelopes). Additional Naval Science Awards certificates are included to be used, as necessary (corrections to certificates, etc).

Senior Projects: Each senior division individual project award recipient (Grades 9 -12) will receive the following:

- Letter of Congratulations
- ONR Medallion
- Naval Science Award Certificate
- Award Verification Form (only original 2017 forms will be accepted) – this form must be completed by the senior division award recipient and **mailed within 30 days** following the fair to TMT Group, Inc. A postage-paid, addressed envelope is included for this purpose.

Gift cards are valued at \$50.00 for regional fairs and \$75.00 for state fairs.

Monetary awards will be awarded to students in **Grades 9-12 only**. **NOTE: Projects must be the work of an individual student; Team projects/group projects are not eligible for awards and will not be honored.** Award recipients must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents of the United States or its territories at the time of selection.

Junior Projects: Each junior division individual project award recipient (Grades 6-8) will receive the following:

- Letter of Congratulations
- ONR Medallion
- Naval Science Award Certificate

Note: Team projects/group projects are not eligible for awards and will not be honored.
