

Naval Science Award Recipients Selection and Recognition

The Academy of Applied Science administers the Naval Science Awards Program for ONR. Award packets are mailed to the Special Awards Chairperson, as designated at the time of fair registration.

The number of award packets (Senior and Junior) sent to the Awards Special Chairperson depends on the number of student exhibits, based on the following chart:

Award Verification Form (only originals will be accepted) - this form should be completed by the Senior Award recipient and returned to the Academy of Applied Science with their gift certificate choice - a postage-paid, addressed envelope will be included for this purpose.

Gift certificates are valued at \$50.00 for regional fairs and \$75.00 for state fairs.

Monetary awards will be awarded to students in Grades 9 -12 only. Projects must be the work of an individual student; no team projects are eligible for awards. Award recipients must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents of the United States or its territories at the time of selection.
